Dear Parent/Guardian(s),

The goal of the admissions policy of Redding School of the Arts is to attract, enroll and retain the broadest spectrum of students and families representative of the rich diversity existing in the County. Redding School of the Arts identifies the following admission requirements and parameters for all students, including school-based students and home school students and including both Regular and Special Education students. Ed. Code § 47605(b)(5)(H) The School does not discriminate against any student based on actual or perceived characteristics of nationality, race, ethnicity, immigration status, religion, sex, gender, ethnic group identification, age, national origin, ancestry, genetic characteristics, mental or physical disability, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression or association with a person or group with one or more of these actual or perceived characteristics or other category protected by law. (AB9)

Application Procedures

- ❖ Complete the attached Redding School of the Arts Application and email to chazeleur@rsarts.org
- ❖ Students who are applying for the current school year will be temporarily added to the bottom of the existing waiting list for a chance to be admitted if a space becomes available. All applications received who have not been enrolled will go through the lottery in May and will receive an authenticated position on the waiting list for the next school year.
- ❖ Attend one of the Mandatory Application Validation/School Orientation Meetings during the last week of April- all submitted applications shall receive an email with exact dates, locations and time of meetings. Parents and students formally apply for a place in the lottery by submitting a completed validated application. Applications are validated by attending a validation meeting during which the academic program, parent requirements, admission policy and lottery procedures are explained in further detail.
- ❖ RSA's Lottery occurs on the first Tuesday in May, the exact date and procedures of the lottery process will be shared at the Application/Orientation Meeting.
- ❖ Students admitted after the lottery will receive a letter mid to late May verifying their placement.
- ❖ Students placed on the waiting list will receive a verification letter stating their place on the waiting list
- ❖ In the event of a vacancy, the school will admit students pursuant to the order specified on the waiting list and the school may require immediate enrollment in the school so as to avoid vacancies during the course of the school year.

Important Steps after being accepted

Please note once accepted into Redding School of the Arts parents/guardians will need to provide the following documentation prior to a student's first day of school.

1. Cumulative records request- Authorization for the school to request and receive student records form all schools the student has previously attended or is currently attending.
2. Copy of your student's most recent report card.
3. A copy of your student's 504 Plan or Individual Education Plan, if applicable.
4. Completed SARB Contract; RSA's charter does not accept students that are on a SARB contract.
5. ALL K-8 students must have proof of immunizations or medical exemption. *(Required for K-8).*
6. Proof of health examinations required by the Health and Safety Code.
7. Proof of age- through documents such as birth certificate or baptism certificate duly attested.
8. Proof of residency- such as, driver's license, utility bill, copy of lease, etc.
9. Parent and Student must read and sign RSA's Family Handbook and agree to follow school policies within.

Admission Policy:

The mission of Redding School of the Arts, where education and the arts connect, is to educate K-8 students who have an interest in visual and performing arts and cultivate their knowledge and skills for the betterment of their local and global community. The School is open to any student in the State of California who meets the admissions requirements described below.

- All students must have been fully immunized and present the appropriate health examination record in accordance with the California Health and Safety Code.
- All students must meet minimum age requirements as applicable under California law and with grade level placement in accordance with RSA board policy.
- No student may concurrently attend a private school that charges the students family for tuition.
- All students shall be documented as residents of the State of California.
- If enrolled in an independent study program, a student shall be documented as a resident of the county in which the charter school reports its apportionment claims or an adjacent county.
- Students with a SARB contract from a prior school in California must first fulfill the mandates of the School Attendance Review Board contract.
- No student will be admitted if he/she has been previously expelled from another educational institution.

Charter School Complaint Notice & Form

California Education Code (EC) Section 47605(d)(4)

(https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?sectionNum=47605&lawCode=EDC)

states the following:

- A charter school shall not discourage a pupil from enrolling or seeking to enroll in a charter school for any reason, including, but not limited to, academic performance of the pupil or because the pupil exhibits any of the following characteristics:
 - Academically low-achieving
 - Economically disadvantaged (determined by eligibility for any free or reduced price meal program)
 - English learner
 - Ethnicity
 - Foster youth
 - Homeless
 - Nationality
 - Neglected or delinquent
 - Race
 - Sexual orientation
 - Pupils with disabilities
- A charter school shall not request a pupil's records or require the parent, guardian, or pupil to submit the pupil's records to the charter school before enrollment.
- A charter school shall not encourage a pupil currently attending the charter school to disenroll from the charter school or transfer to another school for any reason (except for suspension or expulsion).
- This notice shall be posted on a charter school's Internet website and a charter school will provide copies of this notice (1) when a parent, guardian, or pupil inquiries about enrollment; (2) before conducting an enrollment lottery, and (3) before disenrollment of a pupil.
